Toothill Church Covid update

The property committee met last Monday (23rd August) and agreed the following:

- 1 From Sunday 5th September all Covid restrictions will be lifted.
- 2 The wearing of a masks will be an individual choice.
- 3 Seats will be put out as normal, however that does not stop you sitting socially distanced if you wish.
- 4 There will be a basket at the back of the church for offerings instead of passing the basket round.
- 5 Tea and coffee and biscuits will be resumed after the service. (Volunteers required for the kitchen)
- 6 Hand sanitizers will still be available (Which we recommend)
- 7 The NHS QR reader will remain for you to check in if you wish.

- 1 We will be restarting the retiring collection for the Filling Station on the first Sunday of the month.
- 2 We are asking for volunteers to be on a rota to assist with the cleaning of the church (mainly dusting and polishing) the bulk of the cleaning will be done by a cleaner after the children's weekday activities.
