<u>The URC</u>

In the URC we are all invited to come as we are. Some people like dress in Sunday best, others dress for comfort. You may see people wearing their traditional dress, especially when celebrating diversity and cultures.

In some churches, you will the Minister wearing special clothes. It might be a dog collar (special shirt with white strip) or a full-length black overdress called a cassock – each minister can decide what they would like to wear to lead worship.

As members of God's family, we can all bring our unique gifts and talents, whatever our age, to create and participate in worship.

URC Youth bring the concerns and passions and gifts of young people, and the 1990 URC Charter for children reminds us that ALL are equal partners in faith and worship. Work is under way to rewrite this charter, moving us towards and increasingly inclusive intergenerational church.

Trip to the Passion Play in Oberammergau and the Holy Land

Revd Paul Snell (County Ecumenical Officer for Churches Together in Devon) is leading a 10 day pilgrimage to visit the Passion Play in Oberammergau followed by the Holy Land, from 7th - 16th September this year. This is a unique opportunity to cover two sought after visits in one journey.

We fly to Munich, travelling on to Oberammergau, stay over for two nights to see the play (full board on this section of the trip) and then fly on to the Holy Land for a 7 day tour with 3 days in Jerusalem (including Bethlehem), a day visiting the Dead Sea and Masada, and 2 days in Galilee followed by a final day travelling via the Mediterranean coast and Caesarea. This part of the trip is Half Board. We stay in good quality hotels, travel by private coach, have our own local guide and the trip includes full entrance fees to all sites. There is an option of staying on for a further 3 days in Jerusalem.

Full details can be found via these links for the brochure and online booking form. No deposits are required at this stage because of the current ongoing pandemic but will be requested sometime in May.
