#### The URC

Sharing and exploring the word of God together is an important part of our faith. A URC service might start with the Bible being carried in, then follow the pattern of preparing to listen to the word, hearing the word and responding to the word. We share and explore the Bible together, perhaps through a sermon, Godly Play,

storytelling café-style church and discussions, small group Bible studies, and Messy Church. Discipleship is lifelong learning together.

The URC has three Resource Centres for learning that provide formal training and education. (The Scottish College, Cambridge, and Northern College in Manchester) (*Manchester was my training for being a Lay Preacher - David*)

In 2019, the URC launched Stepwise, which is accessible for ALL ages and stages in the URC as part of ongoing discipleship.

From Pilots, serving children and young people since 1936, and Congregationalists developing junior church after the Second World War, to Forest Church today, many churches continue to find new and exciting ways to engage with all ages – not least by creative responses to the Covid pandemic restrictions.
