we pray for the people of Ukraine today.

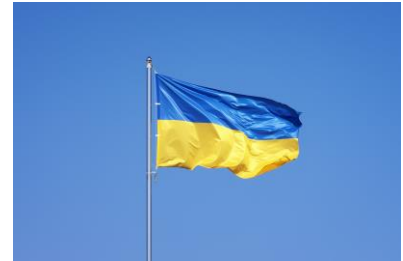
We pray for peace and the laying down of weapons.
