Loving God,

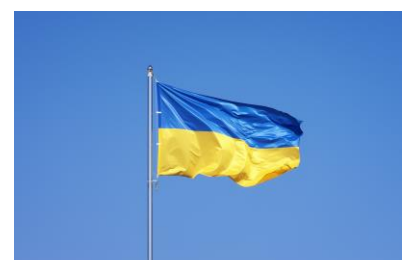
We pray for the people of Ukraine,
