Your will for your people is peace, not war.

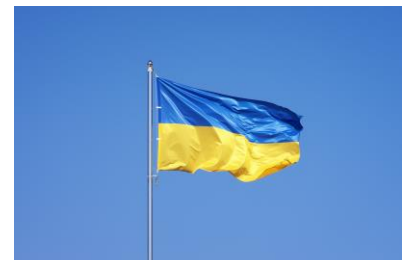
Pour out on our world, especially in Eastern Europe, your Spirit of compassion and solidarity.
