#### **Heat and Eat Fund**

This morning saw the final transaction of the Heat and Eat fund. As you know the sum of £1,000 in cash was given to us anonymously a year ago with a note directing that it be used for the alleviation of food and fuel poverty in our community. We have tried to be as wise and generous as possible with this extraordinary gift. The breakdown of spending has been:

£479.13 to help an individual with the costs of food and fuel;



£520.87 for the provision of food, beverages, newspapers etc for Warm and Welcome Space [now renamed Welcome Space]. However, the cost of heating and lighting the church during the sessions has been borne by church funds.

I have now closed out the Heat and Eat fund. Henceforth we have a new fund labelled Welcome Space which has £441.85 in it.

It just remains for me to say to whoever gave this wonderful gift - thank you! It has proved to be a real blessing to many people during this challenging period of food and fuel poverty.
