Our bills totalled almost £600 in April and reduced to almost £400 in May. We made our usual payments of £500 as our Partnership share. You may remember that we reduced this from £1,000 a month at the start of 2024.

Welcome Space received a grant of £1,000 from the National Welcome Space team in April and we will need to reflect carefully on how we use this money. We will need to provide a report in due course. In other good news West Swindon Parish Council have agreed to grant Welcome Space a further £550. Payment was made in June and will be included in our next financial update. Again, we will need to provide receipts and a report on how we have used this money.

We made and received our Gift Aid claim of £3,845.69 in May. This is transferred to the Methodist Saver account so that we can get the interest on it. This money will be a useful towards our winter fuel bills. We were able to make a Heat and Eat donation to respond to specific need in April.

Water Aid donations for Easter totalled £153.47 and this has been passed on to Water Aid. Filling Station donations decreased to £13 in April and there were no donations at all in May. I will make a transfer to Filling Station in June for the first half of the year.
